<u>2Kings 17:15</u> They rejected his decrees and the covenant he had made with their fathers and the warnings he had given them. They followed worthless idols and themselves became worthless. They imitated the nations around them although the LORD had ordered them, "Do not do as they do," and they did the things the LORD had forbidden them to do.

<u>Luke 6:46</u> "Why do you call me, 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do what I say? <u>47</u> I will show you what he is like who comes to me and hears my words and puts them into practice. <u>48</u> He is like a man building a house, who dug down deep and laid the foundation on rock. When a flood came, the torrent struck that house but could not shake it, because it was well built. <u>49</u> But the one who hears my words and does not put them into practice is like a man who built a house on the ground without a foundation. The moment the torrent struck that house, it collapsed and its destruction was complete."
